TAP (Transition Assistance Program)

The classes are designed for military personnel who are within 24 months of retiring or 90-180 days of separating from completion of military services. It helps Service Members understand the overall Transition Assistance Program, the requirements to meet Career Readiness Standards, and to identify common issues Service Members and their families experience during the transition process.

Contact your Career Counselor to verify qualifications and for registration.

CAPSTONE

This event is a mandatory step of TAP. It should be completed no later than 90 days prior for release from active-duty. CAPSTONE evaluates the Service Member's preparedness to successfully transition from the military to a civilian career.
